Circular

We are receiving many queries about award of grace marks, from students and parents. It is informed that there are different rules for awarding grace marks in different courses because of difference in guidelines of various National Agencies, adopted by Atal Medical and Research University, HP.

The following guidelines are approved by the University and published in the concerned Chapters of the first Ordinance of the University /Notification of concerned National Commission/Council:

Course	Reference in Ordinance	Provision
MBBS	CHAPTER-V: FACULTY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES UG (MBBS) (Page No.77, First Ordinance, Volume-I) Clause 5.11.2.7 (q) University Examinations	The grace marks up to a maximum of five marks may be awarded at the discretion of the University to a learner for clearing the examination as a whole but not for clearing a subject resulting in exemption.
BDS	CHAPTER-VII FACULTY OF DENTAL SCIENCES (Page No.150, First Ordinance, Volume-I)	Grace marks up to a maximum of 5 marks may be awarded to students who have failed only in one subject but passed in all other subjects.
B. Sc. Nursing	INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL NOTIFICATION 5th July, 2021 [INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL {REVISED REGULATIONS AND CURRICULUM FOR B. Sc. (NURSING) PROGRAM), REGULATIONS, 2020 Clause 5.15 EXAMINATION REGULATIONS	If the student has failed in only one subject and has passed in all the other subjects of a particular semester and Grace marks of up to 5 marks to theory marks can be added for one course/subject only, provided that by such an addition the student passes the semester examination.

Post Basic B. Sc. Nursing	CHAPTER-XII FACULTY OF NURSING SCIENCE Post Basic B. Sc. Nursing Degree, Clause 12.7 EXAMINATION SCHEME: (b) (Page No.245, First Ordinance, Volume-I)	Maximum five grace marks may be allowed for one academic year in theory paper only, however, these maximum marks shall not be permitted in one subject; Provided that maximum of 5 (five) grace marks may be awarded to a candidate who has failed in one or more subjects, if it enables him to pass the entire examination.
AYUSH courses, M. Sc. Nursing, B. Sc. MLT, B. Pharmacy (Ayurveda)	Clause 4.14(a) MODERATION OF RESULTS (Page No.23-24, First Ordinance, Volume-I)	A candidate, who appears at an examination, but fails in one or more Course(s)/paper(s), in case of Post-Graduate examinations, and subject(s) in the case of Under-Graduate examinations (written, practical, sessional or viva-voce), and/or in the aggregate (if there is a separate requirement of passing in the aggregate), shall be given grace marks up to a maximum of one percent of the total aggregate marks allotted to the Course(s)/Paper(s)/ Subject(s), as the case may be, in which he/she has appeared to enable him/her to pass the said examination. While awarding grace marks the fraction working to half or more will be rounded off to the next whole number; Provided that in the case of MBBS, BDS, BHMS, BAMS NURSING & PARAMEDICAL examinations the grace marks shall be given up to one percent of the total marks of each subject and shall be awarded subject-wise;

	Provided further that grace marks up to a maximum of five may be awarded to a candidate who has failed only in one subject if it enables him/her to pass the entire examination.
